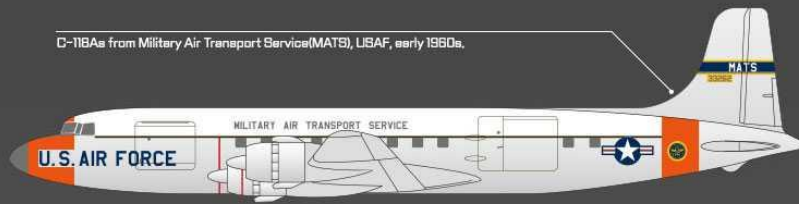
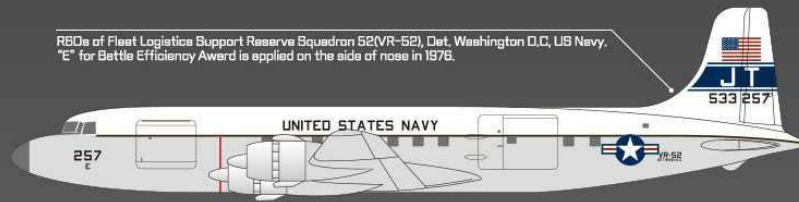

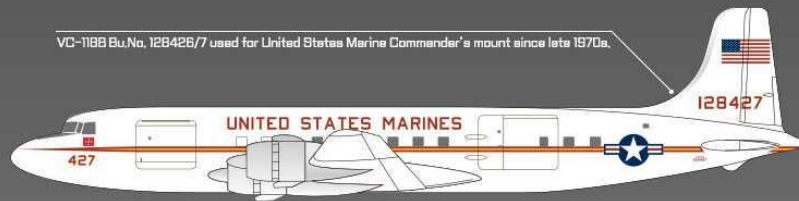
C-118As from Military Air Transport Service(MATS), USAF, early 1960s.



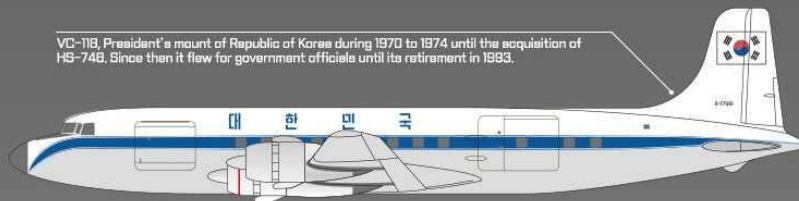

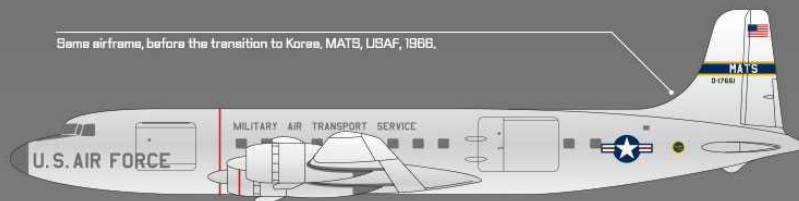
VC-118B Bu.No. 128426/7 used for United States Marine Commander's mount since late 1970s.



VC-118, President's mount of Republic of Korea during 1970 to 1974 until the acquisition of HS-74B. Since then it flew for government officials until its retirement in 1983.

VC-118 53-3303, mount of Supreme Allied Commander Europe (SACEUR) during 1970s.



DC-6B 43536, Republic of China, mount of the President Chiang Kai-shek, 1967. This is named as "Zhongmei", taking one letter from the President's real name (Jiang Zhongzheng) and his wife's, Soong Mei-Ling.
